Document 1: The Energy Mix

The Energy Mix of a country is the specific combination of different energy sources it uses to meet its energy consumption needs.


Despite producing more and more energy from renewables each year, the global energy mix is still dominated by coal, oil, and gas.

Energy production – mainly the burning of fossil fuels – accounts for around three-quarters of global greenhouse gas emissions. In this way energy production is the largest driver of climate change.
