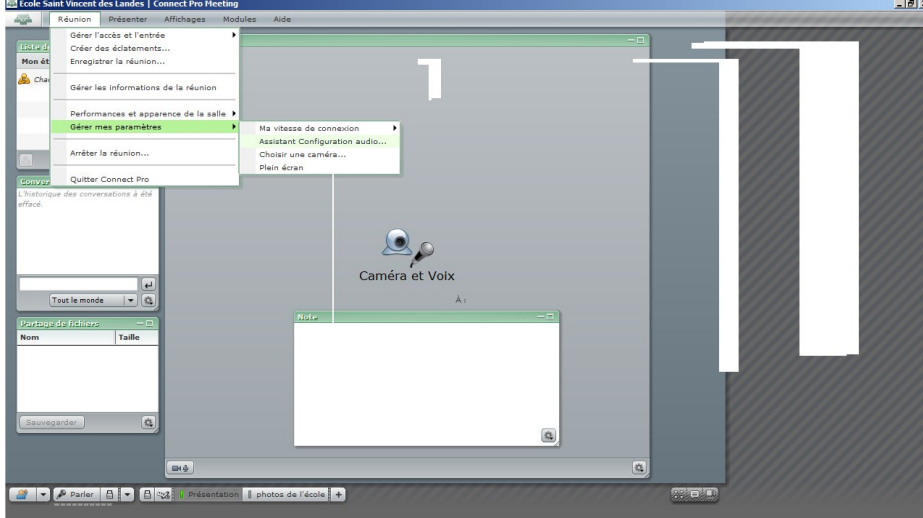
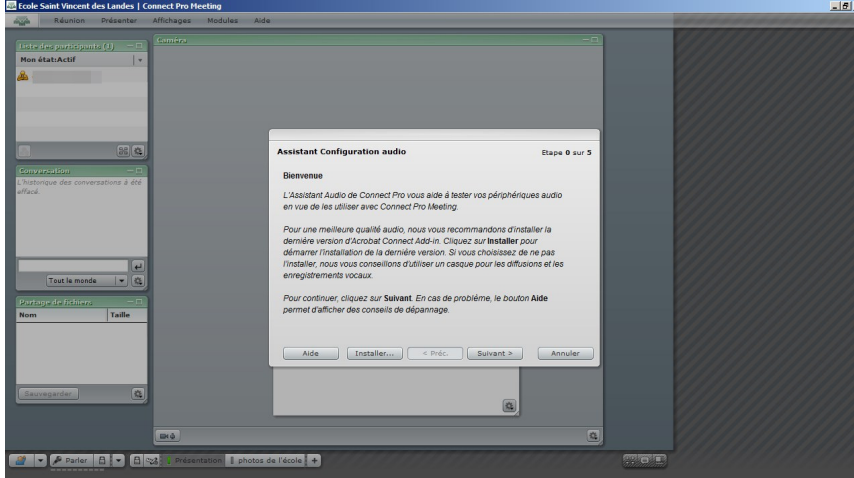


Audio settings on your ADOBE CONNECT virtual classroom
Before you get started, you'll have to check your audio settings, choose the right microphone, etc.

1° Click on “Réunion>gérer mes paramètres>Assistant Configuration Audio »

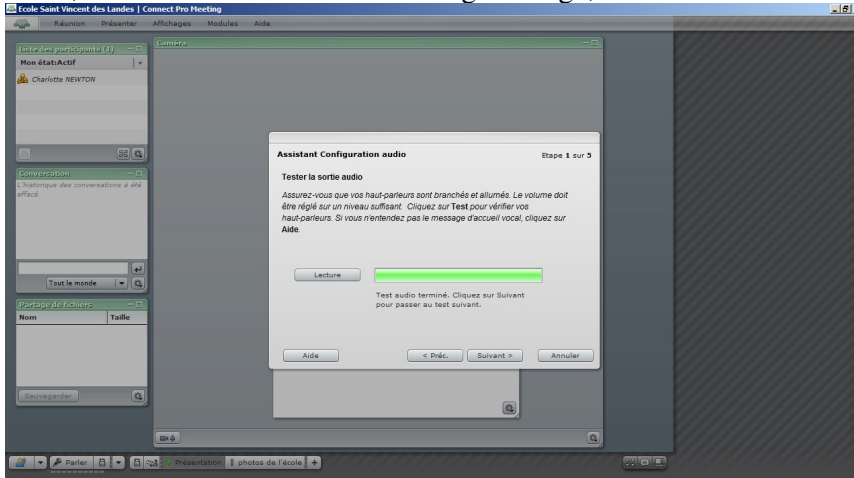


2° Start the audio setting wizard (click on “suivant”):



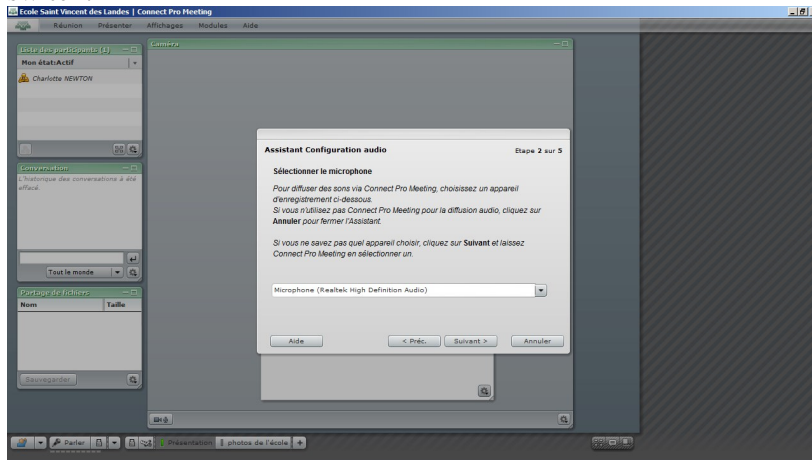
3° Step 1 : your speakers

Click on “lecture”. Normally, you should hear music coming out of your speakers. If not, make sure that the volume is high enough, and that the sound is activated.



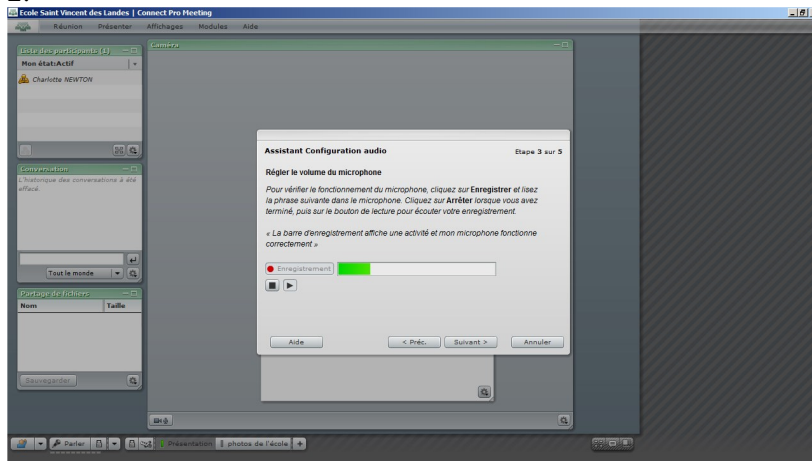
3° Step 2 : your microphone

Choose the microphone you would like to use. In some cases, you'll have up to 3 available microphones (one in the webcam, the built-in microphone of your laptop, a hand microphone). Depending on the activity you want to carry on, you'll prefer one or the other. It is sometimes better to have a hand-microphone with a switch.



4° Step 3 : Test recording

When you press on the red button, you'll start recording a sample, using the microphone that you have chosen before. You'll immediately see if it works, as a green bar will show you the incoming signal. If nothing moves, you should check your microphone, the audio settings of your computer or go back to step 2.



5° Step 4 and step 5

Step 4 will measure the silence, and adjust the sensitivity of the microphone.

Step 5 will give you an access to the advanced settings, whenever you need to adjust the sound volume, if the people you are connected with encounter difficulties hearing you.
