SITUATION:

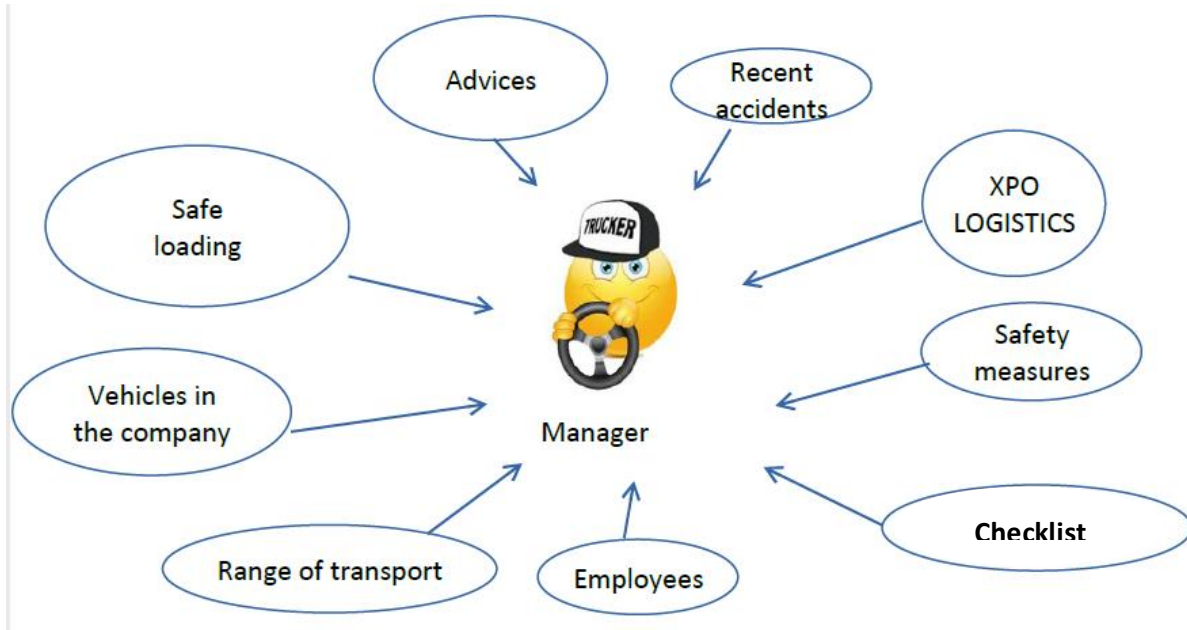
You are an assistant manager in **XPO international logistics** in Manchester, UK.

THE Truck Driver Checklist

Check These Before You Go:

- Don't Drink Alcohol Or Take Any Kind Of Drugs Before Driving Which May Impair Your Driving Skills.
- Avoid Heavy Meals Before Driving As These Can Make Your Feel Drowsy.
- Make Sure The Vehicle Is In Good Working Order & Check Weather Conditions.
- Check The Brakes, Brake Lines, Tyres, Coolant, Engine Oil, Mirrors, Windows, Windscreen Wipers, Lights, Indicators, And Also Emergency Equipment.
- Check The Load & Make Sure The Load Is Every Distributed And Property Secured.
- Check The Legaly Required Documents And Recording Devices On Board.
- Check Your Route & Anticipate Any Bridges, Tunnels, Etc. Where Your Vehicle Might Have A Problem Due To Dimensions, Weight, Dangerous Goods.
